Gift Aid Scheme

The Gift Aid envelopes for the year 2014/2015 are now available for collection from the back sacristy. Please uplift your envelopes as soon as possible and let us know whether there are any changes that you might wish to make to your membership of the scheme.

With our current membership of the Gift Aid Scheme we are recovering approx. £18,000 from the Inland Revenue each year. During this current year only 30.0% of our first collections were donated under the Gift Aid scheme. Any parishioner who pays tax can join the scheme and allow the parish to claim back from the government 25% of their cumulative donations. By joining you could help us move towards our next target which is 40% which will allow the parish to claim an additional £6,000 per annum.

Gift Aid application forms can be found in the porch at the back of the church which give further information on the scheme.
