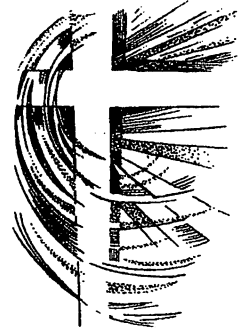
If anyone was bitten by a serpent, he looked at the bronze serpent and lived.
