First Reading Exodus 22: 20-26

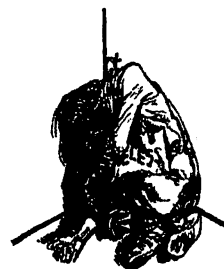
If you are harsh with the widow, or with the orphan, my anger will flare against you.
