#### **SAFEGUARDING: PVG INFORMATION**

"From October 2015 it will be an offence to work/volunteer on a regular basis with children and /or adults at risk without a PVG certificate (Protection of Vulnerable groups). After September 30th 2015 any of your existing parish volunteers who work on a regular basis with children and/or adults at risk, but who have not obtained a PVG through the diocese, will not be able to undertake this voluntary work in the parish until they have done so." Memo from Archdiocese Feb 2015.

Currently ALL our parish volunteers who meet the criteria for requiring PVG have obtained it or are in the process. Our thanks to them. All parishioners are invited to find more information on the parish safeguarding notice board at the back of the Church.

#### PARISH ANNUAL ACCOUNTS - PARISH GROUPS

The financial Year End of the Archdiocese of Glasgow and of Christ the King Parish was on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> Match 2015. We have been given a deadline of Friday 15<sup>th</sup> May by which date we must submit the Annual Accounts of the Parish to the Archdiocese. Under Charities Law we must include all bank accounts in the return which have 'Christ the King' in the Bank Account name.

Would all Parish groups with 'Christ the King' included in their Bank Account name please contact Joe Byers (637 3023) as soon as they receive their bank statement for the end of March 2015? If you receive quarterly bank statements which do not end on March 2015 please contact your bank to order an interim statement showing the balance at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015. Please remember to uplift all bank statements from the office in the church house. I would need to receive all returns by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2915 to meet the Archdiocesan timetable.
