"From October 2015 it will be an offence to work/volunteer on a regular basis with children and /or adults at risk without a PVG certificate (Protection of Vulnerable groups). After September 30th 2015 any of your existing parish volunteers who work on a regular basis with children and/or adults at risk, but who have not obtained a PVG through the diocese ,will not be able to undertake this voluntary work in the parish until they have done so."
