Good things came your way, just as bad things came the way of Lazarus.

Now he is being comforted here while you are in agony.



Another parable unique to Luke. The author describes the rich man to draw admiration from Jesus' hearers; Lazarus is a figure of horror and repulsion. In death, their fortunes are reversed. Even in torment the rich man has not learned his lesson. He wants Lazarus to be sent to warn his brothers! Prophetically, Abraham says that if these brothers do not heed the prophets, they would not heed even someone who rose from the dead!
