If only you had faith!



The disciples ask Jesus to increase their faith; his response indicates that quantity is not important—faith even the size of a mustard seed would enable them to tell a tree to be uprooted and plant itself in the sea. No trees move, so we may presume that, if Jesus wasn't exaggerating to make his point, the disciples' faith is smaller than the mustard seed! Jesus' parable makes clear that faith consists in our implicit and unswerving trust in God always; quantity is not important.
