Jesus' journey to Jerusalem is over, and he gives an impressive response against the temple authorities trying to catch him out. In this passage, Sadducees, who did not believe in the resurrection, concoct an improbable tale of a women who must marry seven brothers in succession since each died childless. Jesus discredits their strategy by pointing out that they have reduced God to the God of the dead, instead of the God of the living!
