On the Solemnity of Christ the King, it's not surprising that Jesus' kingdom is at the centre of the gospel. Today's gospel is about the exchange between Jesus and one of those crucified beside him. The kingdom is not presented as something remote and unattainable; the sinner who acknowledges he has done wrong and who asks Jesus to remember him when he comes into his kingdom, is told: "today, you will be with me in paradise"!
