This is a holy man of God, let him rest there.

Second Reading Romans 6:3-4. 8-11

When we were baptised we went into the tomb with Christ, so that we too might live a new life.

Gospel Matthew 10:37-42

Anyone who does not take his cross is not worthy of me. Anyone who welcomes you welcomes me.

Matthew's second 'sermon' (of a total of five) is directed toward disciples' missionary activity. In this week's extract, a disciple who prefers anyone or anything to Jesus is not worthy of the name disciple. A bit harsh? Remember that this gospel was written to energise a community discouraged by persecution. There is much more to this passage, however. Demands of discipleship may at times be hard, but the rewards are greater still!

The last mile and a half to Scalan, from Chapeltown is along a country track requiring sensible shoes, and one should be prepared for any weather. Cars and minibuses, but not coaches, can get very close to Scalan. Thankfully, like good Christians, those who take their cars along this track can be confidently waved down by those who would like a lift.
