The word of the Lord has meant insult for me.

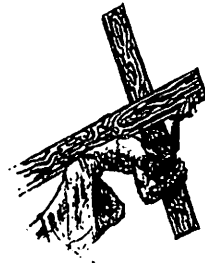
Second Reading Romans 12:1-2

From Rock and keeper of the keys, to 'Satan'! When Peter tries to end Jesus' talk of dying, he forgets disciples are to follow Jesus—not lead him! 'Get behind me' is another translation of how Jesus first called Peter—'follow me'. Jesus' rebuke is also a renewed call to discipleship. Peter is called Satan, because had he succeeded here, he would have done what Satan failed to do at Jesus' testing in Matthew 4:1-11.
