Sermon four of five from Matthew's gospel provides today's gospel. This is directed to the community. What is to be done regarding a wrongdoer? We can almost hear echoes of an early Christian debate! Jesus teaches that on the one hand, the community must be saved from damage at the hands of wrongdoers, but on the other, every compassionate effort must be made to help the wrongdoer undergo a change of mind and behaviour.

ACN has developed plans to repair and rebuild, and the people's confidence has begun to return, with more than 80 per cent now interested in returning home.
