First Reading Isaiah 5:1-7

The vineyard of the Lord of hosts is the House of Lords.

Second Reading Philippians 4:6-9

The God of peace will be with you.

Gospel Matthew 21:33-43

He will lease the vineyard to other tenants.

The most famous of the parables in Matthew which centre on the vineyard, a long standing Jewish scriptural image symbolising Israel. This parable is about the owner (God) who sent various messengers whom they rejected and even killed. The final one sent is the owner's son, whom they kill. In Matthew's version, Jesus makes the chief priests and elders pronounce their own fate: they say the owner will bring the tenants to a wretched end!
