First Reading Isaiah 45:1. 4-6

I have taken Cyrus by his right hand to subdue nations before him.

Second Reading Thessalonians 1:1-5

We constantly remember your faith, your love and your hope.

Gospel Matthew 22:15-21

Give back to Caesar what belongs to Caesar—and to God what belongs to God.

The key here is a Pharisee carrying a Roman coin in the Temple precincts. A big deal? Yes! Roman coins had the head of Caesar on them. They carried the inscription "Tiberius, son of the divine Augustus", an image and an inscription about a false God—infringement of the very first commandment. The coin carriers ask Jesus if it was lawful to pay taxes to Caesar. They give Caesar his due: but they do not give God what is due!
