We need to remember that the sole purpose of bridesmaids was to have a light ready for the bridegroom. The five without oil simply have not carried out their only task!

GIFT AID SCHEME MEMBERS

A certificate was recently sent out with the Annual Statement of each members contributions to the scheme and the amount of tax rebate that we had recovered from the Inland Revenue based on those contributions. This year ninety nine certificates have been returned which amounts to 65% of the scheme members. This percentage is roughly the same as in previous years. *Are you one of the 35%?* To be certain that our information is up to date and correct we use this system as an internal audit and the Inland Revenue have the right to audit our control systems.
