*A busy day at Capernaum! Mark's account of Jesus' first miracle is the casting out of an unclean spirit in the synagogue, interestingly described as new teaching—not new action. Before this action, people were amazed at Jesus' words, not related by Mark, but impressive enough for the congregation to recognise words of authority, unlike those of their own scribes. Jesus teaches in words and actions which are totally consistent with each other.*
