With language which is used by St. Paul to describe the resurrection, Mark says that Jesus 'raised up' the sick woman. A new element has been introduced at this early stage. Jesus comes to give the fullness of life to broken humanity, seen in the conclusion of today's gospel with a summary account of very many healings.
