First Reading Leviticus 13:1-2. 44-46

The leper must live apart: he must live outside the camp.

Second Reading Corinthians 10:31 –11:1

Take me for your model, as I take Christ.

Gospel Mark 1:40-45

The leprosy left him at once and he was cured.

Jesus is alone in an unknown village. A leper does the unthinkable (and illegal!) in approaching Jesus, saying "If you want to, you can cure me". Jesus replies "Of course I want to". Then he does the unthinkable: he touches the leper. Under the law, Jesus now takes on the condition of the leper, who is now clean. This is an indication of what Jesus' death will mean: changing places with sinful humanity!
